1. HARDWARE OVERVIEW



2. HARDWARE INSTALLATION

- 1. Attach the two antennas to the device.
- Connect the equipment to the numbered device ports (Serial 1/Serial 2) using appropriate cables and adapters.
- 3. Mount or place the device securely.
- 4. Connect the unit to the network via the supplied Ethernet cable using the Ethernet (RJ45) port.
- 5. Supply power to the device by using the included power adapter.
- 6. Via the computer connected on the same network, you can follow one of two paths to device discovery and initial network configuration as outlined below.



3. IP ADDRESSING

The Ethernet port on PremierWave XN defaults to DHCP assigned IP address. If your network does not support DHCP, then PremierWave XN will fall back to using an automatically generated IP address (Auto IP) within the 169.254.0.0 subnet.

If you want to assign a different IP address, it must be within a valid range, unique to your network, and within the same subnet as your workstation. To configure the PremierWave XN, you will need the following:

4. DEVICE DISCOVERY

There are two mechanisms available in order to discover the assigned IP address and to perform the rest of the device configuration over the network.

4a. USING DEVICE INSTALLER

INSTALL DEVICE INSTALLER

- Download the latest version of DeviceInstaller from http:// 1. www.lantronix.com/downloads. The minimum version required for DeviceInstaller is 4.4.0.1.
- Run the executable to start the installation process on the 2. computer being used to configure the PremierWave XN.
- Respond to the installation wizard prompts. 3.

USING DEVICE INSTALLER

Run DeviceInstaller, Click

Start > Programs > Lantronix > DeviceInstaller > DeviceInstaller

- Click the Search icon. 1.
- 2. Select the unit from the list of Lantronix products discovered on the local network
- 3. Double click the unit in the list. Details about the unit will be displayed.
- 4. Select the Web Configuration tab and click on the green arrow. You will be prompted for username and password
- The default USER ID = admin and PASSWORD = PASS (both are case 5. sensitive)

4. USING uPnP

ABOUT uPnP

Universal Plug-N-Play (uPnP) is built into Windows 7 and higher. With uPnP Discovery, no additional software is required and a list of discovered devices is automatically refreshed.

Note: Please ensure that Network Discovery is turned On for the active network profile under

Control Panel > Network and Sharing Center > Advanced sharing settings

USING uPnP DISCOVERY

On power up, PremierWave XN will appear in Network folder inside Windows Explorer. Each PremierWave XN displays the serial number and firmware version so it can be uniquely identified.

- Select the unit you wish to configure from the list of discovered 1. Lantronix products
- Right click the selected unit and select View Device Webpage to 2. bring up the Web Configuration UI. You will be prompted for username and password.
- 3. The default USER ID = admin and PASSWORD = PASS (both are case sensitive)
